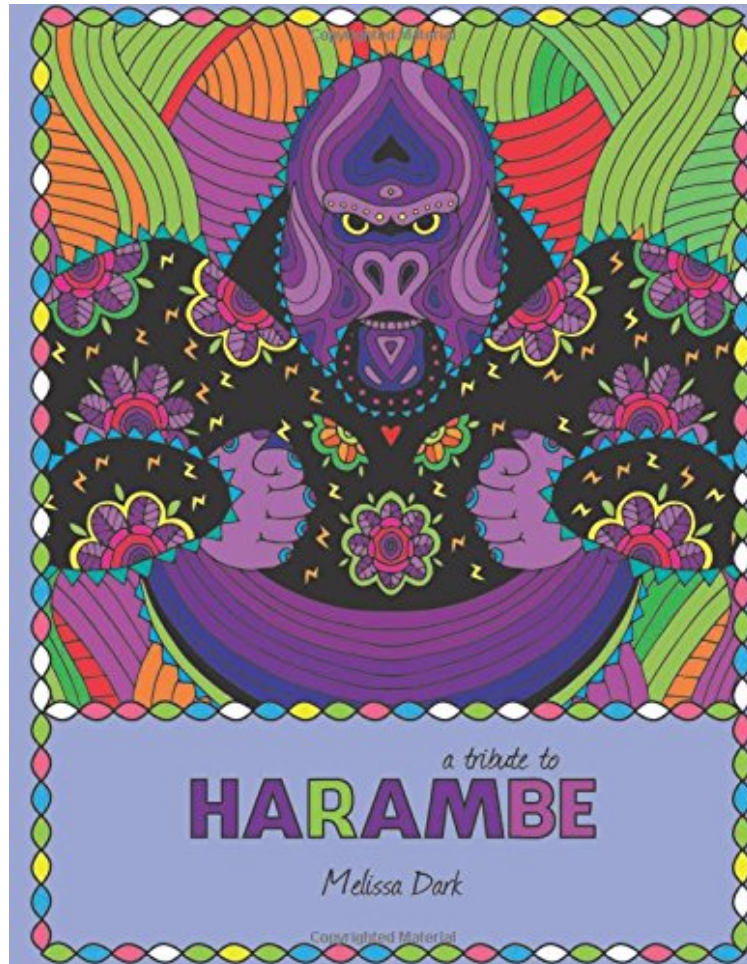

The other pictures to color are of other animals that live in Africa. Examples include elephant, zebra, and lion. The coloring pictures are small; most take up less than half a page. There is only one coloring picture per page; it's not double sided. The only redeeming quality of this book was the tribute at the front. I would recommend to you not to purchase this coloring book.
