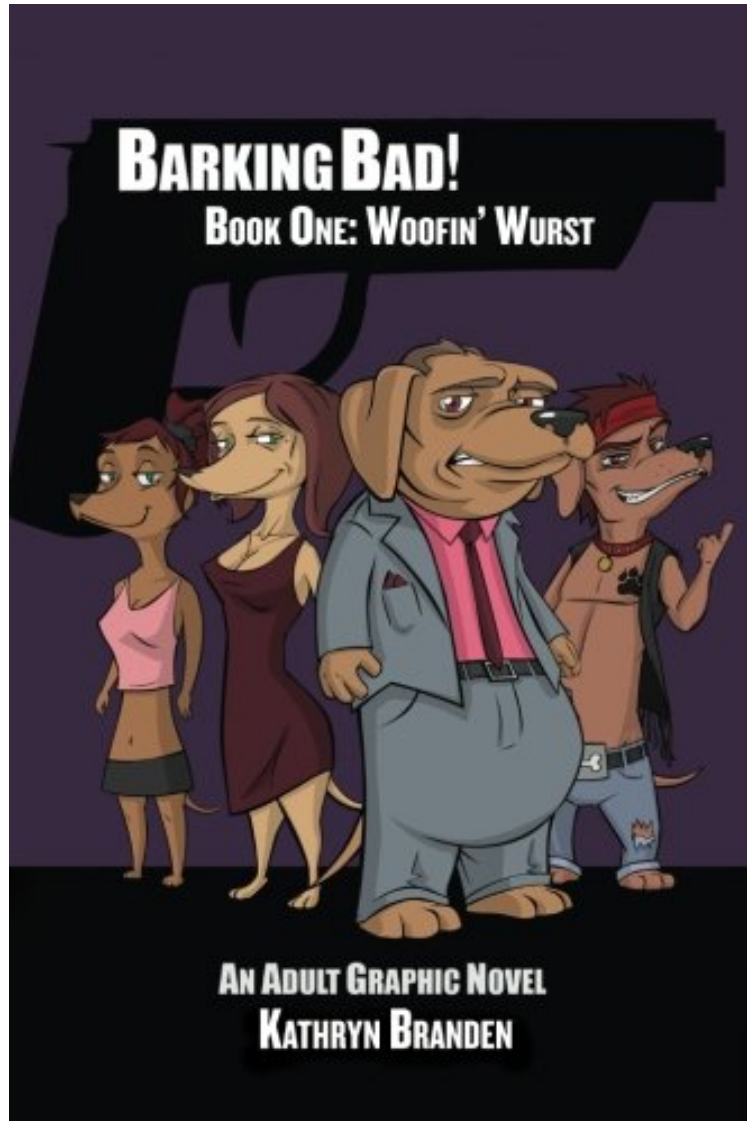

Maybe you thought the FBI had vanquished the organized crime world; well here its just gone to the dogs! Book One: Woofin Wurst sets the stage (or should I say the lineup); the characters are an assortment of doggies starting with the best, the Wursts a Dachshund litter, right out of Family Ties until well, very soon its more the Sopranos. Just when I thought I was out, they pull me back in (by the tail). Heres a cleverly written, funny epic with remarkable cartooning and the underworld dogs and cats you always wanted to meet except you werent brave enough to hang out in their alleyway. The author and artists are giving us a two for one: a pulp fiction narrative that leads us readers around dark corners and a graphic style artwork of imagination that speaks to hidden erotic and violent thoughts we just cant discuss over dinner. The author makes crafty use of our cultures pet phrases to lead the story along to the end of book one. But I dont want to let the cat outta the bag. This is well worth the ride and leaves you wanting to know . . . whats next. Its on to Book Two.

Sometimes their BITE is worse than their bark. so dont step on their paws! Such is the re-occurring theme throughout this edgy cartoon saga of a modern day canine Mafia family, their friends and associates. This story explores the underworld activities of the Canine Cartel in New Jersey and their ongoing struggles dealing with adversaries and the authorities. BROCK WURST, a criminal, older Dachshund and Top Dog of the New Jersey Canine Cartel gets into a turf war with MR. LABATZKI, a sinister Rottweiler from the Canadian Canine Cartel. In this ongoing conflict, Brocks family, along with his gang members are thrust into the dynamics of an underworld lifestyle, placing them in life threatening situations. Brocks pack of made" mongrels are constantly clawing their way out of situations they create while miss-behaving rather than obeying orders from Brock. With extortion, money laundering and treat (drug) deals going on in Mexico, Canada and the Caribbean, an endless cast of cantankerous characters enter and exit their lives. Capturing the antics and misadventures of the family members, as well as the diverse personalities of their canine and feline companions, this story takes us on a whirlwind journey of suspense, laughter and love, with surprising twists and unexpected betrayals. Although these characters may BARK BAD, they keep us smiling!
