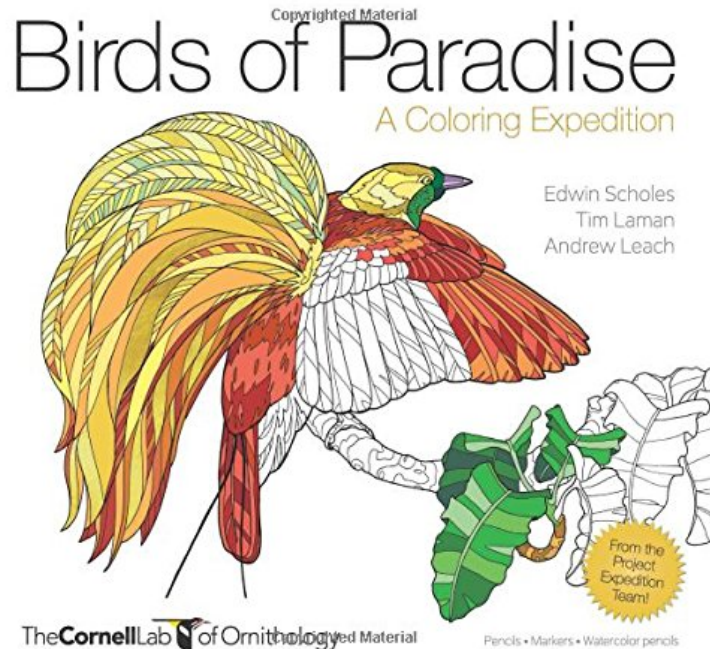

The backgrounds are very sparse and 2. The lines are often a bit "messy" in the book and very thick. A book can have lines that are too thick and others, much too thin. These lines are really quite thick (in my own opinion only) and I think it takes away a bit from the finished product. These pictures do not take long at all to color. I wish there were more birds with very vibrant colors as so many are black or in hues that are mostly black. Birds of paradise are really very colorful and beautiful. I love, too that they included a name for the birds as I don't know a lot about specific birds and was able to easily look them up. As well, there is a fold-out cover with images of each bird represented in the book which is very, very helpful if you cannot look them up online as you color.
