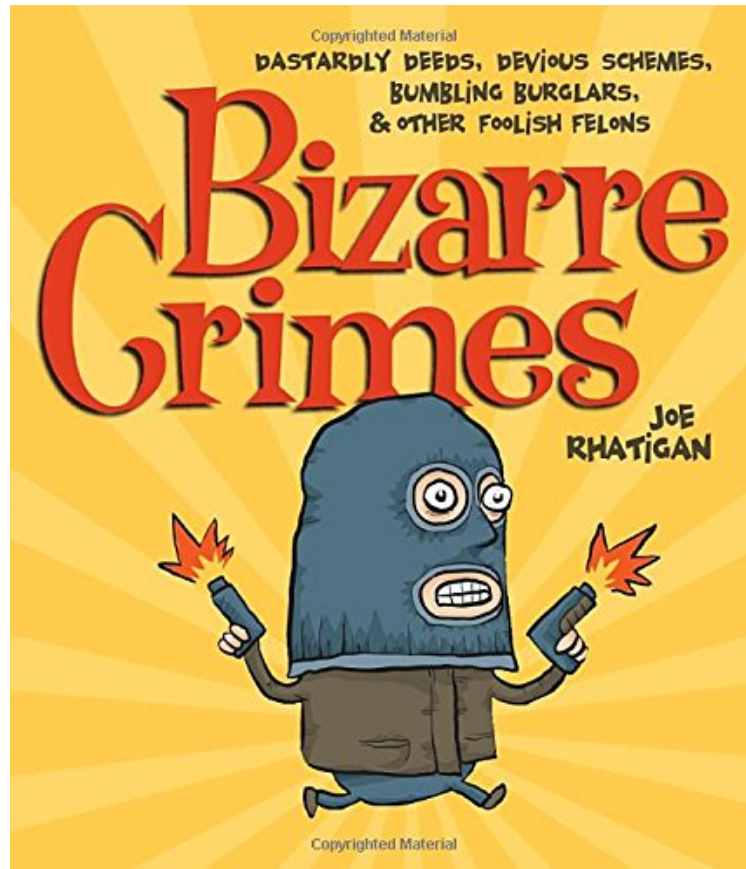

This book is very entertaining and suitable for most ages. Each crime and criminal is given about a paragraph of description so there are many different crimes covered in this book. Also, they are grouped by category; what immediately comes to mind is the Getaway category and the Motive category. One of the getaway crimes was the man who robbed a bank and used

an inner tube to get away and yet, one of the motives was a man who couldn't stand seeing Bristol Palin advancing in Dancing with the Stars. This book is good light reading and not very long. A person could finish the book the same day, or just casually spread out the reading over several days. It's a great travel book in my opinion.
