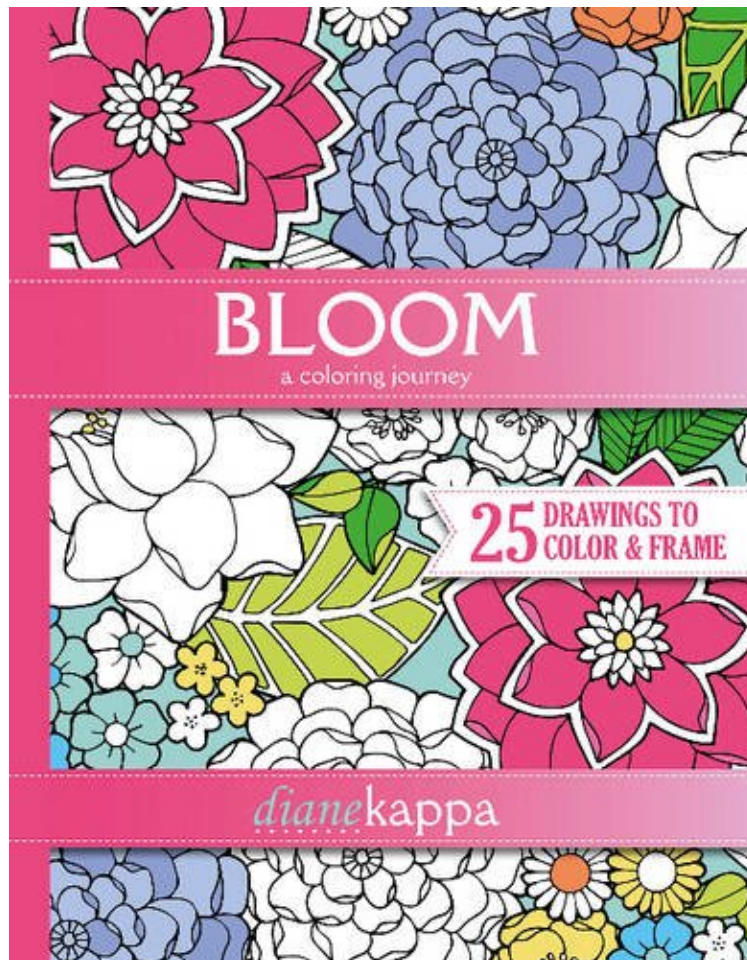

pages come out easily- I hate it when you discover that the pages don't easily come out or you have to cut them. I love Diana's patterns and found this book to have a great variety of designs- from large to intricate, so there's something for whatever mood you are in!
