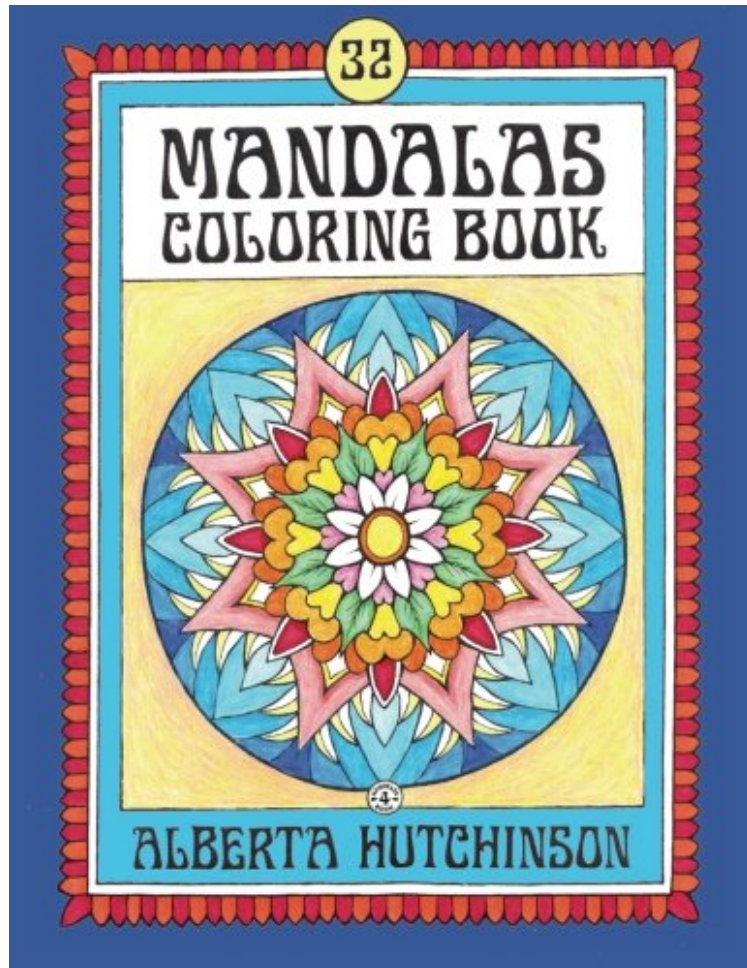

Nice big mandalas, easy on the eyes, and fun to color using a variety of pens and markers.The only complaints I have (and their minor ones), the designs are not printed on perforated paper. Certainly not a deal breaker, but for some reason I found these a little tougher to tear out. Also, some

of the mandalas were quite similar. I always recommend using a blank sheet of paper underneath, as there will be bleeding. Especially when using alcohol based markers.
