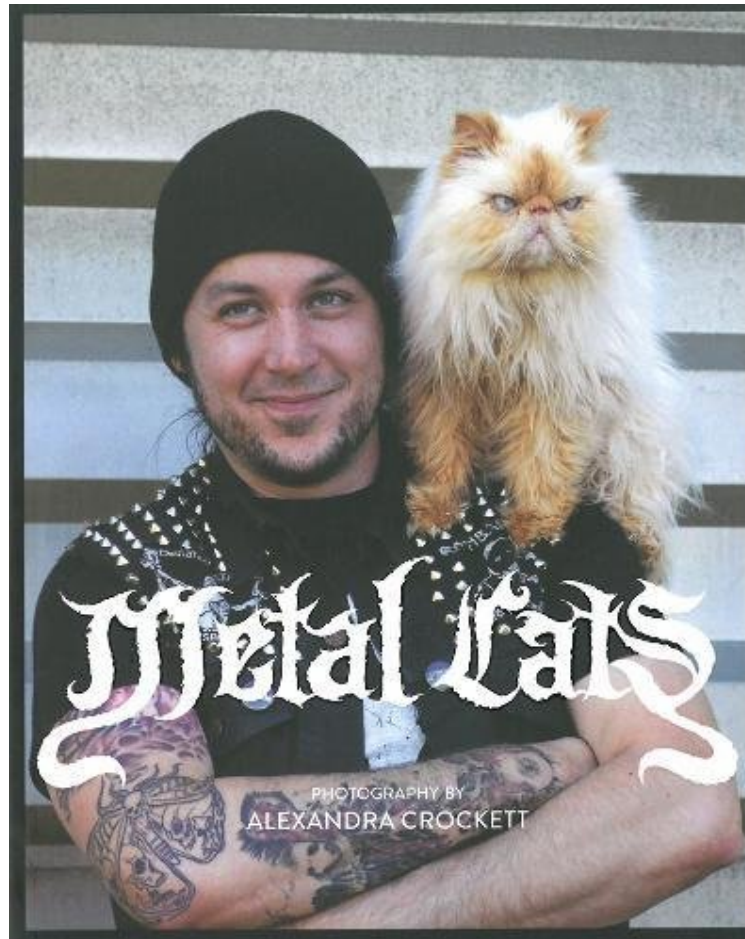

However... this book portrays another side of their inner souls. Viewing both sides of their mutual bonds opens our eyes to two often misunderstood personalities. However, I wish the author had provided the artist's identification with each picture. Having to leave the page and resort to a "non-index" really diminished the mental engagement of man and animal. As a cat-lover (not so much into "rock..), I bought this book for talented musician friends who understand and willingly live by the rules of their felines.
