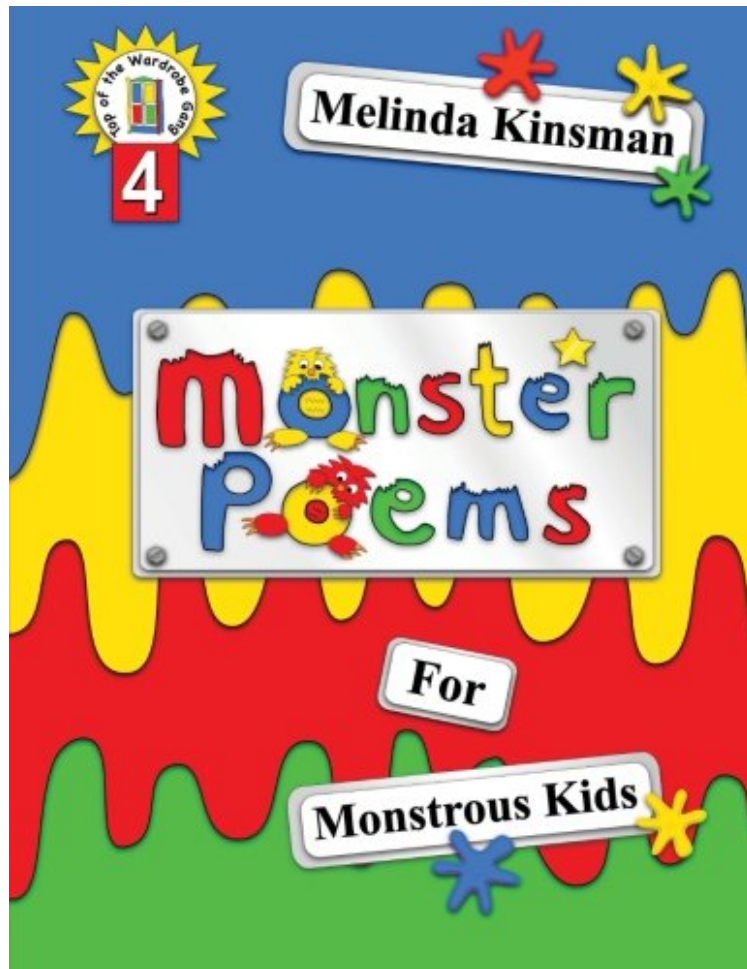

favorite book of The Top of the Wardrobe series. Billy's stuffed toys that sit on the top of his wardrobe are at it again...this time they are off to hunt for monsters! Monsters are lurking in some familiar places like under the bed as well as places in which you would never expect to find them like the car wash. The monsters really are not very scary because they are depicted as comic characters in the colorful illustrations. This book is targeted for children age three through eight so it is perfect for siblings to share. Each page contains four lines in verse. The monsters are personified doing tasks like knitting, baking and playing chess. Billy does have a problem; there is not enough room for all these monsters under his bed. My favorite story is the one at the car wash. A lot of children are afraid of the car wash. Viewing it as a place where these friendly monsters work can be one way to see it as an amusing experience. I love Molly who has huge fantastic lungs to blow the cars dry, and Norris who polishes everything up bright. For children afraid of monsters, Billy shows how turning on the light is the way to get them to run away because they are more afraid of you than you are of them. Hunting for Monsters provides a safari adventure for children in which they hunt monsters not animals. By using exaggeration and fun illustrations in these silly stories, children will soon have their fears turned into laughter. It makes for great bedtime story reading night after night; each poem story is long enough for young ones to get drowsy and fall asleep. You'll find monsters everywhere, under the bed, at the car wash, on the steps, in the shed, even a cute one who loves to knit socks living in the bathroom sink. There is a monster the color of purple, who is grumpy, selfish, and sly; one with three eyes, who likes eating cakes, custard, lettuce, and pies; one who has a pet log, who thinks it's a dog; and there's even one who takes over the kitchen and bakes stupendous cakes. Who knows where else you'll find these friendly monsters, perhaps, right inside this book--it's worth a look

About the Author Melinda Kinsman was born in Stoke-on-Trent. She lives on a peninsular in the UK called The Wirral, which lies just to the north of Wales. She holds a PhD in Chemistry, and is fairly new to being an author - having created her first ebooks for children at the end of 2013. She loves climbing mountains and rock-climbing (both abroad, and in her local mountains of Snowdonia), and she has always had a soft-spot for cuddly toys! As Melinda has to lie down a lot each day, due to health issues, she now spends most of that time using her iPad to write and illustrate her new books. Melinda originally wrote a book of poems for her 6 year old niece a few years ago, but never dreamt of trying to publish them, or of trying to illustrate them herself. The advent of ebooks and handheld tablets now makes self-publishing an exciting possibility for her! The Top of the Wardrobe Gang series of books are credited to both Melinda and a motley crew of cuddly toy characters. This bunch of cuddly toys live on the Top of the Wardrobe - they like to call this the "penthouse suite"! They enjoy reading, and want to try writing their own books. Most of the cartoon gang characters are based on "real" members of Melinda's cuddly toy family, though some have had to have their names and appearances changed to allow their inclusion!
