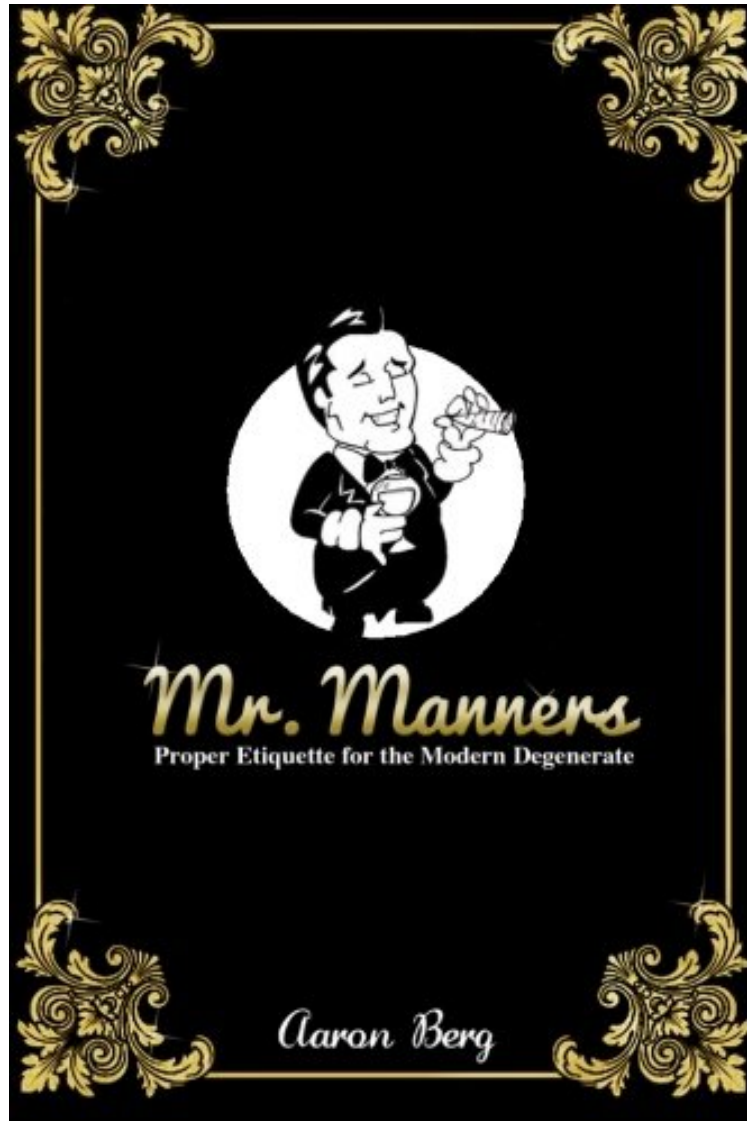

Klaxworm Aaron Berg has long been one of Canada's top comedians, writers and performers and his debut book is nothing short of cover to cover proof of why that's the case.
