traditional and detailed Christmas designs. There is a focus on certain types of designs. I found a lot of design with ornaments, wooden soldiers, and Christmas elves that looked a lot more like gnomes. The interesting difference with this book is that the same design is printed on both front and back of the page. That way you can color the same designs twice or you can treat the page like a single page design and ignore the back of the page. It works well for both right and left hand colorists as you don't have to work over the "hump" of the binding. Just choose which page works best for your writing hand and color that one. For me, I will use the book as a one-sided design book. My coloring medium of choice will either bleed through or leave dents on the back of the page. Because of that, the back of the page won't be in good enough shape (due to the cheap CreateSpace paper) to be useful. The designs are detailed with lots of elements to color. Some of the designs have intricate and small areas to color. These may require small nib pens/markers and thin, sharp pencil points for coloring. Because of this, I don't recommend this coloring book to any one who has fine motor or vision issues. This is what I discovered while coloring in this book and testing my coloring medium on the paper: 51 Traditional Christmas Designs. The same design is printed on both front and back of the page. Paper is typical inexpensive quality by CreateSpace printing: white, thin, slightly rough and non-perforated. The designs merge into the binding area. If you cut your pages out, you will lose part of the design. Glue Binding. Alcohol-based markers bleed through the page quickly. Water-based markers bleed through in spots. Gel pens and India ink pens leave shadows on back of the page. India ink can bleed through if you apply heavily or multiple coats. Coloring Pencils work well with this paper. I found that I could layer the same color for deeper pigment or multiple colors and I could blend easily using a blending stick. I tested both oil and wax based pencils. I also found that hard lead pencils leave dents through the paper. I like to use a blotter when working in the book. I use a page of card stock or several sheets of heavyweight paper under my working page. It keeps seeping ink and marring dents from ruining the pages below.

The book contains more than fifty adult coloring designs, each doubled on the back of the sheet for a total of 102 pages to color. Thus you could start over coloring a given image using a different approach and have a two-sided image to stick to your window, glass door or cubicle divider and share the festive vibe. Or you could ignore the left sides and treat the sheets as single-sided. If you find a design to be too intricate – disregard some lines and color groups of two, three or more details as one. If you find a design to be too simple – innovate, draw between the lines, make it more intricate, make it your own. Fun-seeking adventurers of all ages will enjoy coloring cuddling cubs, napping bears, sleeping dogs, Christmas trees, toys, Santa's workshop elves and a multitude of festive mandalas. Kids and grown ups alike will enjoy meeting: a laughing Santa; Santa, hurrying in his sled, pulled by reindeer; Santa's helpers (gnomes, elves and dwarfs); toy figures of characters from the "The Nutcracker" ballet (soldiers, bishops and kings); a master cat (puss in boots) in a plush costume with a sled full of presents and a Christmas wreath; a flute-playing frog; a turkey (before experiencing its black swan moment); smiling snowmen in hats and scarves; gingerbread folk (gingermen and gingerwomen) and a squirrel or two. Leo wouldn't be forgiven hadn't he included lots of mistletoe leaves and poinsettia flowers, snowflakes, Christmas tree toys, giant socks, garlands, mittens, caps, bells, Christmas stars, sugar canes, hearts, Christmas snow globes and snow toys, classic holiday presents (such as a rocking horse, a doll house, ice skating shoes), some snowy pines and snow-capped peaks thrown in for a good measure and perhaps a whimsical clock and a castle. Fans of the crafts may find inspiration or decoration ideas in the motifs and patterns between these covers. Relax, enjoy the holidays, do good, radiate warmth, be happy and blessed.
